Thank you for your entry. Please read these final instructions as they have the same force as the Supplementary Regulations.

Covid-19

- 1. The venue has changed to Warren Farm, Green Tye, nr Much Hadham, Essex, SG10 6JE with the entrance at map reference 167/453191, lat/long 51.851415, 0.108024 (51°51'05.1"N 0°06'28.9"E). A map of the approaches to the venue is included. Please drive carefully and considerately both to and from the venue, as we do not want to give others a bad image of motorsport.
- 2. The Motorsport UK Steward is Mr. Brian Hemmings and the Event Stewards are Malcolm Wise and Nick Foord. The Covid-19 officer will be Chris Deal. South Oxon CC is invited to the RS Clubmans Autocross. Additional award The Old Park Trophy for Best GBMC member on the Summer Autocross.
- 3. Shared vehicles are allowed, the changeover must be done at your servicing point with appropriate sanitising before the second driver takes over, then go to the head of the queue for the start line.
- 4. Refreshments will be available at the site. Please take your rubbish home. Toilet facilities are available in the paddock; remember to wash your hands before and after entering the toilets sanitisers will be outside.
- 5. Please check the weather forecast and dress appropriately.
- 6. Times will be sent out by txt and they will be updated on the club's website with any penalties. There won't be any formal award ceremony, but awards can be collected from the race control trailer when advised then made final.
- 7. NO quad bikes, motorbikes, drones (due to overhead power lines and planes) nor open fires.
- 8. Please ensure that all young persons are kept under close watch at all times, as the Organiser's will not be liable for any injury howsoever caused.
