1. Your competition number is shown on the attached entry list; this must be displayed on each side of your vehicle. A limited supply of competition numbers will be available at signing on.

- 2. The notice board will be located at signing on. MSA Permit No. 75911 has been issued. The MSA Steward is Alan Barnard, and Peter Cox will be the Deputy Clerk of the Course.
- 3. Some points to note from the Chief Scrutineer.
  - 1. You are reminded of the need to have a timing strut fitted as per S10.9.
  - 2. Remember to check your crash helmet is valid and you have fireproof gloves. Also check that your overalls are compliant
  - 3. Competitors in classes A1 to A8 to ensure that the identification on all tyres is clearly visible (i.e. make and type) and that they comply with minimum depth requirements.
  - 4. Remember to bring all your vehicle documentation with you (Tax, MOT etc.).
